### Leadership

### **Strategic Planning**

#### **Organizational Management**

As Vice Commander of the 83,000-person Air Force Materiel Command (AFMC), directed the planning and execution of the most significant cultural and organizational change in the Command's 20-year history. With shrinking budgets and a need to improve business efficiencies and cost-effective execution, restructured the Command from twelve to five centers, eliminating 1,000 positions and saving \$109M per year in overhead costs.

Established disciplined financial processes affecting over 260 F-16 upgrade projects to turn around financially stressed weapon system portfolio. Developed tools and training in conjunction with improved financial management to optimize execution of \$500M/year modernization budget. Drove process improvements to solve severe funding shortfalls in \$2.5B fleet sustainment requirement affecting 3,000 aircraft at 90 worldwide locations.
