- *Major General Dwyer Dennis, US Air Force, recently retired as program executive officer for C31 and networks, Air Force Life Cycle Management Center, Hanscom AFB, Mass—where he managed a \$10.9 billion defense portfolio.*
- *Dennis will join Dayton Aerospace’s board of directors as executive vice president effective 1 January 2019, filling the role vacated by Lt. Gen C.D. Moore, USAF (retired).*
